The Compilation Process

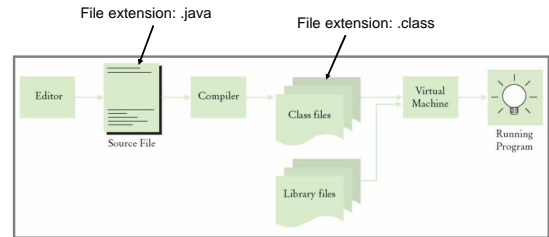
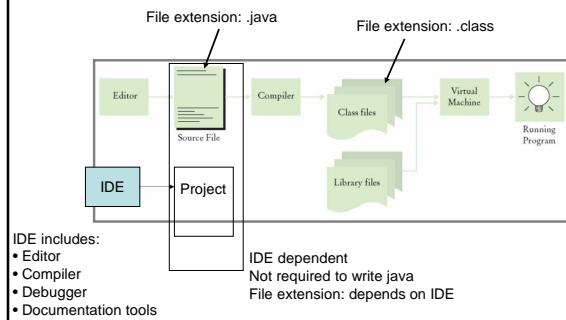


Figure 14: From Source Code to Running Program

Modified Compilation Process



Errors

- Syntax errors

```
System.ouch.print("...");
System.out.print("Hello");
```

– Detected by the compiler

- Logic errors

```
System.out.print("Hello, Word!");
```

– Detected (hopefully) through testing

– Sometimes referred to as “bugs”

Random Piece of Trivia

- Anyone know what the first known computer “bug” was?
 - It was literally a bug...
 - A moth caught in a relay switch of a huge electromechanical computer in 1947

The Edit—Compile—Loop Test

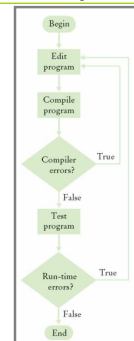


Figure 15: The Edit—Compile—Loop Test
